

- **1.** This classroom was built in 2013 with the money donated by Maria Ksenou, a local resident. It cost 30.000€.
- **2.** Our largest classroom. Apart from its size, it is a typical one. All our classrooms have overhead projectors, interactive whiteboards, are airy and sunny, clean and warm. Students sit one by one in the desks due to the pandemic measures.
- **3.** The main corridor leading to the Head teacher's office and the teachers' one further down, the classrooms and the toilets.
- **4.** The walls are covered with posters from projects, certificates and prizes the students of our school have won throughout the years.
- **5.** This our eTwinning board. We are proud to have our eTwinning school label there, along with our project posters.
- **6.** A large painting hangs on the corridor wall made up from small paintings representing a small part of the famous painting "the Starry Night" by Vincent Van Gogh. It was created last year by students as an Arts and Crafts project.
